As you can see, SKFFL's "Winningest" Head Coach remains Jake Kachelmeyer, with 130 career wins over 15 seasons, good for the best win percentage in the league. Jake has scored over 27K career points, and is always a strong contender for one of the coveted playoff spots...even if he's destined to always be on the outside looking in, never earning a Championship despite all his efforts.

I'm next, with 117 wins and over 26K career points, also over 15 years. Kevin is another 15 year veteran, but his numbers... well, not so good. He's near the bottom of the pack with his win percentage of 0.443. That's nowhere near the historical low of 0.286, a record held by Brian Kasprowicz (who last played in 2008-2009)... although it looks like Matt is trying to push for that record.

Newcomer Shannon Davis has only been with us for 1 year, but his win percentage is currently 2nd only to Jakes, at 0.600. Can he push Jake for the top spot? Probably, Jake is just destined to be 2nd best at everything.

The members of the Council of Elders has shrunk by one with the departure of Erik - all that remains are Jake, Kevin, and myself. I will also continue the tradition of referring to all sub-.500 teams as the League of Losers - consisting of Kevin, Joe (Pulver), and Matt.

Our shortest tenured owner is Joe (Frocci), our latest team owner/victim. He's owned his team for about 5 days now. Is he destined for greatness? Can he perform better than his very mediocre wife? Or will he end up swimming in the muck with Matt? Only time will tell...

Jake is also at the top of the class in terms of cashes - with 9 cashes and 33 weekly high scores over 15 years - but none of those cashes are that all-important 1st place. Even Tami has a 1st under her belt (from 2018). Hell, 4 active owners have taken 1st a combined 11 times. It has gotta bug the shit out of Jake to never have gotten there. But hey, he has 6 2nd place finishes. Way to go, Bridesmaids!

Ken has had a few good seasons as of late, with THREE championships over the last THREE years (2020-2022)...giving him 5 1st place finishes, exceeding my own 3 wins, making him the owner with the MOST lifetime SKFFL championships. Take that trophy and shove it up your midget ass, Ken.

Only three owners have cashed more seasons played than not - Jake (9 cashes over 15 years), yours truly (8 cashes over 15 years), and Ken (7 cashes over 13 years). These are the sharks, and you all are chum.




PRE-DRAFT POWER RANKINGS

After much computation (with a little assistance from Computer Jerry), the following Power Rankings were generated based off of the strength of each team's keepers (as ranked by FantasyPros.com's 2023 ECR rankings) compared to 2023 keeper salaries. A score combining the two factors was created, with a lower score indicating that there are more higher scoring keepers per BoT than other teams. For reference, movement compared to last year's standings is also listed.

I also asked ChatGPT to rank our teams, noting that we have a 2 QB/2 TE league, and that these were incomplete rosters...asking it to providing positives and negatives for each team, and to calculate rough odds of winning the championship. I like these better, because it ranked me 1st.

Roster Notes -

Another team that foregoes the TE position. Even though Jake had both Kelce and Kittle, each were pretty pricey (especially Kelce at 43 (.)(.)). He could dominate the TE position if he kept Kelce, but would it be worth the price?

Jake loves RBs, especially injured RBs. Usually he leaves the draft with like seven of them, and usually half of those are on IR by week 7. So I'm not surprised he decides to just jump the line this year and gamble on a banged-up Breece Hall. Akers is a bit of a crap-shoot too, but ended last year strong - but Jake goes an alternate route, with a cheaper Pacheco.

Jake does have WR Pickens as a cheap 10 (.)(.) option as well, but Brown is a few tiers higher on most lists I look at, and is a pretty solid keeper for 12 (.)(.) more than Pickens.

You'd think Breece Hall would be enough of a risk, but Jake pushes his chips all in and rolls with Tua, who is one stiff breeze away from another concussion. Admittedly, Tua's still probably a safer bet than Russell, who was Jake's projected keeper due to cost and upside (in that, he has no where else to go but up).

RB Jacobs has some noise going on related to his contract and salary demands, but at the end of the day will end up forced to play out the season as the primary RB for the Raiders. WR Wilson gets an immediate upgrade with Rodgers throwing him the ball over Wilson. And finally, the projected McBride would have been a decent TE flier (and now potential week 1 starter) for minimal cost, but instead Shannon rolls with a 28 (.)(.) WR Tyreek Hill - going for stud power over dollar power.

FLM could have opted to keep Hockenson at 20 (.)(.), and also has a slew of other WR options - Watson at 10 (.)(.), Higgins at 15 (.)(.). FLM also has to let the likes of Dalvin Cook and Jonathan Taylor go, but doesn't really suffer a lot for it (especially with Taylor mailing it in for the first several weeks of the season, looking to get out of Indy).

So Shannon spends a ton, but assures himself some top notch talent. FLM, unfortunately, will remain a contender this year. What an asshole.

Jawsh Allen is forced to go with NO QBs - because all the ones he had suck, with 3 out of the 4 not even starters anymore. He could've kept Ridder at 10 (.)(.). As it is, Kevin is short at QB AND TE, with less money at the auction available to him to remedy the situation.

Kevin was projected to keep Evans and Chig; I get wanting to save money with a potentially dried up Evans, but it is probably a tactical error to NOT keep a TE for 10 (.)(.) in this league... depending on demand, Chig might possibly go for more than that in the auction.

Regardless - Kevin gets a very high end RB and possibly the top WR - at a steep overall price and goes into the auction at a positional and monetary disadvantage. I'd wish him good luck with that, but I kinda want to see him fail miserably.

Keenan is going to have a better year, and Ken will regret this keeper pick as well.

And finally, at TE, Andrews would obviously be the preferred keeper, but Engram had a surprising year and is almost 20 (.)(.) cheaper - so this season, Ken's two favorite teams are Chicago AND Jacksonville. That's bound to go well, I'm sure.


